

Unpossessed singular words for clothing generally begin with an *ah* sound.
Unpossessed plural words for clothing generally begin with a *dee* sound.

Words for clothing in Cherokee are often modified with a Pronoun to indicate the Possessor of the clothing. Words for clothing are modified with the First Person Singular Pronoun *agwa-*, the Second Person Singular Pronoun *tsa-*, and the Third Person Singular Pronoun *u-*.

If there is more than one piece of clothing of the same kind, the word is modified with *di-/ts-* Plural before the Pronoun.

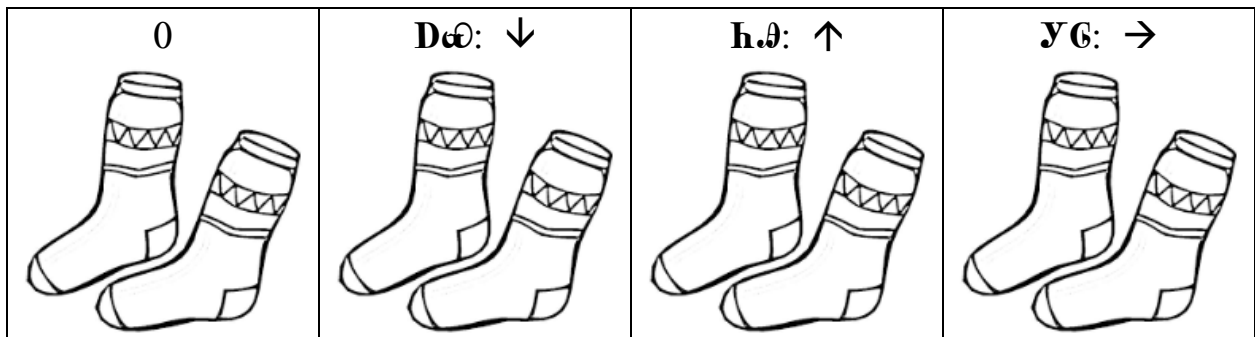

Jacket is exceptional. It generally does not take Pronouns for possession. Instead, the Possessive Adjective -atseli 'possess' is used.
